- CalAgrAbility is part of a nationwide network of United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) programs that began through the 1990 Farm Bill.
- A partnership between the University of California Farm Safety Center (Cooperative Extension) and Ability Tools.
- A bilingual project that helps link farmers, farm workers, and ranchers with disabilities to vital assistance services
- A bilingual educational program that helps promote the awareness of disabilities among agricultural communities.
- A bilingual program encouraging farmers, agricultural workers, ranchers and their families to continue working in agriculture.
